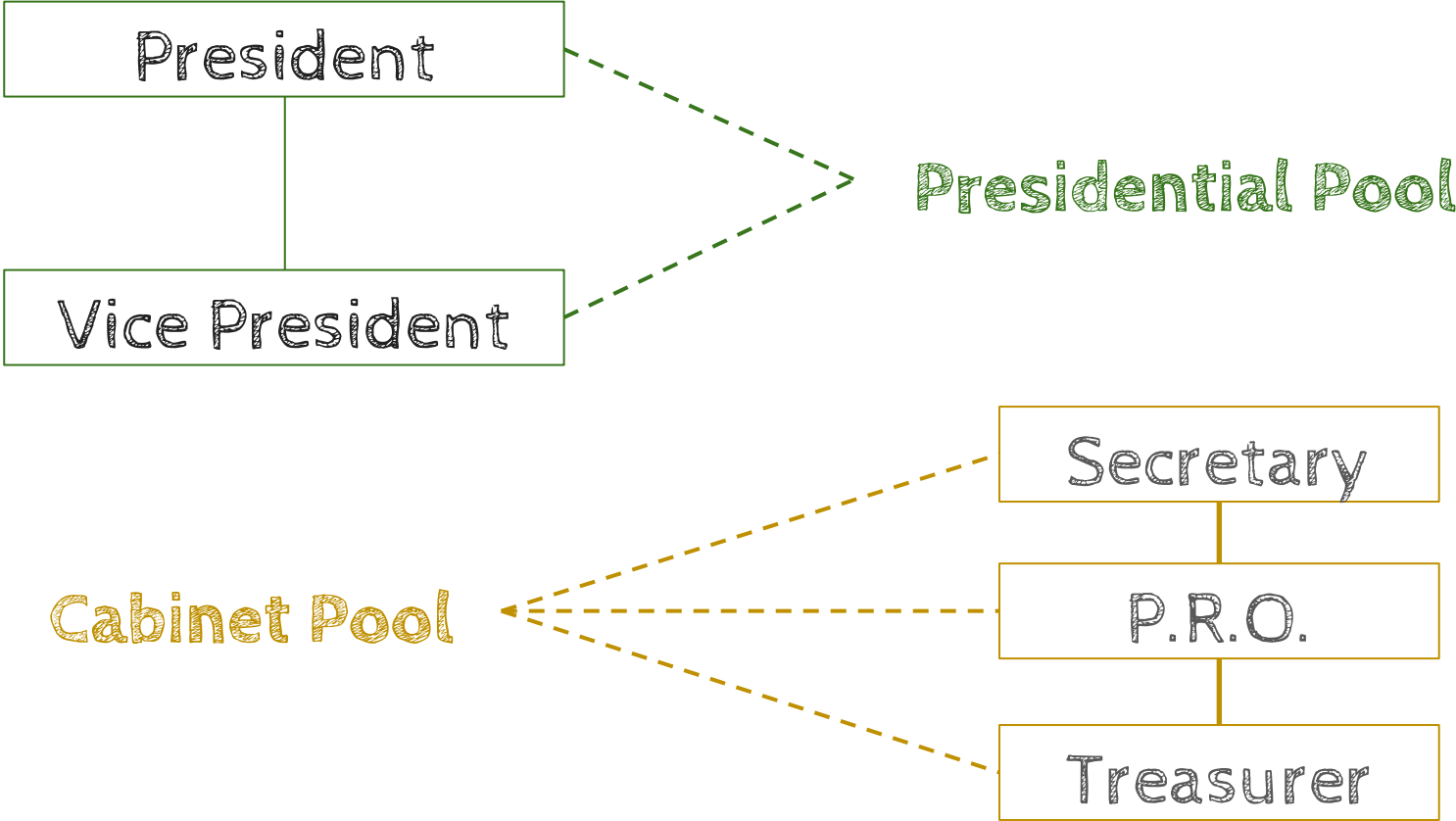
What Would a Council Member Look Like?
